

COOKIES USAGE POLICY

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Certain features of our site depend upon cookies to function and are deemed, within the law, to be strictly necessary (essential cookies). You will not be asked for your consent to place these cookies however you may disable the cookies via your browser settings.

The cookies we use are "analytical" cookies. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around the site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the list below:

UTMA

This cookie is typically written to the browser upon the first visit to our site from that web browser. If the cookie has been deleted by the browser operator, and the browser subsequently visits our site, a new utma cookie is written with a different unique ID. This cookie is used to determine unique visitors to our site and it is updated with each page view. Additionally, this cookie is provided with a unique ID that Google Analytics uses to ensure both the validity and accessibility of the cookie as an extra security measure

Expires: Now + 2 years

UTMB

this cookie is used to establish and continue a user session with our site. When a user views a page on our site, the Google Analytics code attempts to update this cookie. If it does not find the cookie, a new one is written and a new session is established. Each time a user visits a different page on our site, this cookie is updated to expire in 30 minutes, thus continuing a single session for as long as user activity continues within 30-minute intervals. This cookie expires when a user pauses on a page on our site for longer than 30 minutes

Expires: Now +30 Minutes

UTMC

This cookie operates in conjunction with the utmb cookie to determine whether or not to establish a new session for the user. In particular, this cookie is not provided with an expiration date, so it expires when the user exits the browser. Should a user visit our site, exit the browser and then return to your website within 30 minutes, the absence of the utmc cookie indicates that a new session needs to be established, despite the fact that the utmb cookie has not yet expired.

Expires: End of session

UTMZ

This cookie stores the type of referral used by the visitor to reach our site, whether via a direct method, a referring link, a website search, or a campaign such as an ad or an email link. It is used to calculate search engine traffic, ad campaigns and page navigation within our own site. The cookie is updated with each page view to our site.

Expires: Now + 6 months

OTHERS

These cookies offer the website visitor a more “personal” experience by controlling the menus, animations and font sizes for better viewing. These cookies will change the way a website looks and/or behaves. These cookies are NOT used for targeted advertising purposes.

ANALYTICS

Our site also uses third-party cookies to collect anonymous traffic data about your use of our site. This information is stored by Google and subject to their privacy policy which can be viewed here:<http://www.google.com/privacy.html>. Google Analytics collects information such as pages you visit on our site, the browser and operating system you use and time spent visiting pages. The purpose of this information is to help us improve our site for future visitors.

By using this website, you agree that we may store and access cookies on your device. You can refuse all, or certain, cookies by activating this setting on your browser. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.
